## CANTERBURY LOCAL BODIES' OFFICERS (OTHER THAN CLERICAL)—AMENDMENT OF $$\operatorname{AWARD}$$

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Canterbury Local Bodies' Officers (Other than Clerical) award, dated the 18th day of May 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 865.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:
- (1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 6 (Salaries) and substituting the following subclauses:—
- "(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of salaries payable to the undermentioned classes of officers of all local bodies, including those in Timaru not specifically provided for in subclause (b) hereof:—
  - "(i) Traffic Officers: Traffic officers shall be paid a commencing salary of £501 19s. 8d. per annum, with annual increases over four years until £565 4s. 8d. per annum is reached.
  - "(ii) Combined-duties Officers: Officers combining the duties of any two or more of the following duties—health, traffic, building, and dangerous goods—shall be paid £593 19s. 8d. per annum.
  - "(iii) Foremen, &c.:-
    - "County foreman or overseer: £593 19s. 8d. per annum.
    - "Borough foreman or overseer: £565 4s. 8d. per annum.
    - "Reserves foreman: £524 19s. 8d. per annum.
    - "Riding foreman or foreman under engineer, County Clerk, or Town Clerk (other than county or borough foremen): £485 10s. per annum.
    - "Adult chainman: £474 per annum.
    - "Water ranger: £497 per annum.
  - "(iv) Technical and Professional:-
    - "First Division registered architects, surveyors, engineering assistants: £593 19s. 8d. per annum.
    - "Second Division architects, surveyors, engineering assistants: £536 9s. 8d. per annum.
    - "Cadets: Where cadets or chainmen under twenty-one years of age are employed, the minimum weekly rates of wages shall be in accordance with the following scale:—

- " (b) Special provisions for Timaru Borough Council:-
  - "(i) Traffic Officers—
    - "Where more than one traffic officer is employed-

"First Officer: £605 9s. 8d. per annum.

- "Other officers: Other officers shall be paid a commencing salary of £508 17s. 8d. per annum, with annual increases over four years until £565 4s. 8d. per annum is reached.
- " (ii) Sanitary Officers-
  - "Chief Sanitary Inspector: £565 4s. 8d. per annum.
  - "Sanitary Inspector (certificated): £542 4s. 8d. per annum. "Sanitary Inspector (uncertificated): £513 9s. 8d. per annum.
- "(iii) Foremen, &c .-
  - "Borough engineer foreman: £593 19s. 8d. per annum.

"Waterworks foreman: £565 4s. 8d."

(2) By inserting after clause 6 the following new clause:—

## "Exclusion from Operation of General Order

- "6A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the general order of the Court, dated the 30th January 1951, and made under the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1950."
- (3) By deleting from the undermentioned clauses the figures and symbols set out in the first column hereunder and substituting in each case the figures and symbols respectively set out in the second column hereunder:—
