INVERCARGILL CITY COUNCIL CLERICAL WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Invercargill City Council Clerical Workers industrial agreement, made on the 31st day of May 1950 and recorded in 50 Book of Awards 599.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows :—

(1) By deleting clauses 4 and 5 and substituting the following clauses :---
