

NEW ZEALAND LIFE ASSURANCE AGENTS, CANVASSERS, AND COLLECTORS—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the New Zealand Life Assurance Agents, Canvassers, and Collectors award, dated the 25th day of September 1951, and recorded in 51 Book of Awards 1627.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Rate of Remuneration) and substituting the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of remuneration to be paid to workers covered by this award shall be £8 9s. 4d. per week.”

(2) By deleting clause 6 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

(3) By deleting from the undermentioned clause the figures and symbols set out in the first column hereunder and substituting in each case the figures and symbols respectively set out in the second column hereunder:—

Clause 5 (b)	£6 £1 10s.	£6 18s. £1 14s. 6d.

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1952.
