

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS CLERICAL EMPLOYEES**—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Public Accountants Clerical Employees award, dated the 19th day of August 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2163.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 15 (Salaries) and substituting the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum weekly salaries payable to employees:—

“Provided always that no such employee who has had any office experience in addition to accountancy experience shall be paid less than the appropriate minimum salary payable under the Shops and Offices Act:

“Provided, further, that any employee who has had six years' accountancy experience, and has been admitted by examination to the New Zealand Society of Accountants, shall be paid 11s. 6d. per week in addition to the wage prescribed above.

(2) By inserting after clause 15 the following new clause:—

“*Exclusion from Operation of General Order*

“15B. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the general order of the Court, dated the 30th January 1951, and made under the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1950.”

(3) By deleting from the undermentioned clauses the figures and symbols set out in the first column hereunder and substituting in each case the figures and symbols respectively set out in the second column hereunder:—
