WHAKATANE BOARD MILLS LTD., AND N.Z. FOREST PRODUCTS, LTD., WOOD-PULP AND PAPER PRODUCTS WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Whakatane Board Mills Ltd., and New Zealand Forest Products, Ltd., Wood-pulp and Paper Products Workers award, dated the 28th day of December 1950, and recorded in 50 Book of Awards 2177.
