

TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, MARLBOROUGH, NELSON, AND WESTLAND
LOCAL BODIES' OFFICERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, and Westland Local Bodies' Officers award, dated the 17th day of April 1951, and recorded in 51 Book of Awards 342.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 9 (1) of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the above-mentioned award, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the parties, this Court for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (f) of clause 5 (Rates and Conditions of Pay) and substituting the following subclauses:—

“(a) All male officers shall be paid in accordance with the following scale:—

“(f) Meter-readers:—

“General scale up to and including eleventh year, with a minimum commencing salary of £410 7s. if twenty-one years of age or over.

“Readers who collect cash shall be paid a cashier’s risk allowance of 5s. 9d. per week in respect of each week during which cash is collected.”

(2) By deleting from the under-mentioned clause the figures and symbols set out in the first column hereunder and substituting in each case the figures and symbols respectively set out in the second column hereunder:—
