

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **GLOVE WORKERS** — AMENDMENT OF
AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Glove Workers award, dated the 24th day of December 1951 and recorded in 51 Book of Awards 2158.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by regulation 9 (2) of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the above-mentioned award, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 25th day of July 1952) shall be further amended by deleting the symbols and figures “ £9 11s. 7d.” wherever they appear in clause 11 (Wages of Junior Males) and substituting in each case the symbol and figure “ £10.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 1952.
