OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND RETAIL CHEMISTS' ASSISTANTS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1953; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Retail Chemists' Assistants award, dated the 20th day of November 1951, and recorded in 51 Book of Awards 1995.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by regulation 6 (2) of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1953, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the above-mentioned award, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the parties, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 8th day of August 1952) shall be further amended by deleting paragraph (ii) of subclause (a) of clause 5 (Wages) and substituting the following paragraph:—
