RIMUTAKA TUNNEL CONTRACT TUNNELLERS AND OTHER WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Rimutaka Tunnel Contract Tunnellers and Other Workers award, dated the 8th day of September 1952, and recorded in 52 Book of Awards 1646.

Upon reading the joint application of the original parties for amendment of the Rimutaka Tunnel Contract Tunnellers and other workers award, dated the 8th day of September 1952, and recorded in 52 Book of Awards 1646, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—
- "(1) By adding after the words 'Rimutaka Tunnel Contract' in clause 1 (Interpretations) the words 'and the Maori Bank Tunnel Contract'.
- "(2) By adding after the words 'Rimutaka Tunnel Works' in clause 12 (Fares) the words 'or Maori Bank Tunnel Works."
- 2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
