

AUCKLAND HOSPITAL BOARD **CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS**—VARIATION
OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Auckland]

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, this 3rd day of September 1954, between the Auckland Hospital Board (hereinafter called "the Board" or "the Employer") of the one part, and the Auckland Provincial District Local Authorities' Officers' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the Union"), of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties that the Industrial Agreement made between the parties on the 16th day of September, 1953 shall be and is hereby varied in the manner following:—

Rates and Conditions of Pay

1. That Clause 3 (b) be amended by adding the following designations:—
Class 5—

Administrative Assistant to the Medical Director, National Women's Hospital.

Class 6—

Administrative Staff Supervisor.

2. That the following clauses be added:—

3. (k) The Board may engage a worker at any rate in Class I, being not less than the amount to which the worker is entitled, and may, at its discretion, grant an allowance for merit or additional responsibility undertaken, not exceeding £50 per annum above any rate determined in accordance with this agreement.

3. (l) That Endorsed School Certificate be classed as the equivalent of University Entrance and that full-time University study may be counted in full as clerical experience.
