

WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL **CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS—**  
 AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District—  
 In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and  
 the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1953; and in the matter of the  
 Wellington City Council Clerical and Other Officers Award, dated the  
 31st day of December 1953, and recorded in 53 Book of Awards 1501.

UPON reading the application made by the parties to the Wellington City  
 Council Clerical and Other Officers Award, dated the 31st day of December 1953,  
 and recorded in 53 Book of Awards 1501, the Court, in pursuance and exercise  
 of the powers conferred on it by regulation 4 (2) of the Economic Stabilization  
 Regulations 1953 and by section 162 of the Industrial Conciliation and  
 Arbitration Act 1954, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—  
 (1) By deleting clause 6 and substituting the following clause:—

*“Increase in Rates of Remuneration*

6. The rates of remuneration determined by this award shall be increased  
 to the extent and in the manner prescribed by the general order of the Court  
 made under the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1953, and dated the 28th  
 day of October 1954.”

For the purpose of removing any doubts as to its application, it is hereby  
 declared that the provisions of this clause shall have no effect upon the salary  
 limits specified in clause 1 defining the application of the award.

(EXPLANATORY NOTE.—The general order of the 28th October 1954  
 increased rates of remuneration determined by awards and industrial agreements  
 by an amount equal to 13 per cent thereof, but excluded from the scope of the  
 increase—

- (1) Such portion of the remuneration of each worker in each week as  
 exceeded the amount of £12 in the case of adult male workers, the  
 amount of £9 in the case of adult female workers, and the amount  
 of £7 in the case of male and female workers under the age of 21  
 years; and
- (2) All allowances in respect of tools, bicycles, motor vehicles, protective  
 or special clothing, or special footwear.

The term “remuneration” means salary or wages; and includes time and  
 piece wages and overtime and bonus and other special payments; and also  
 includes allowances, fees, commission, and any other emolument, whether in  
 one sum or several sums; and also includes travelling expenses.)

(2) By deleting the symbols and figures “£809 18s.” and “£516” in  
 paragraph (ii) of clause 1 (Application of Award) and substituting the symbols  
 and figures “£830” and “£530” respectively.

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day  
 of November 1954.
