**NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT) GENERAL
RETAIL SHOP-ASSISTANTS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts.—
In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954: and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) General Retail Shop-Assistants award, dated the 29th day of April 1955, and recorded in 55 Book of Awards 545.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 162 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) General Retail Shop Assistants award, dated the 29th day of April 1955, the Court doth hereby order as follows—

1. That clause 12 (Females Employed in Special Departments) of the said award shall be amended by inserting a comma between the word “manchester” and the word “furnishing-drapery”.

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.

MEMORANDUM

The necessity for this amendment arises from an error in the printing of the 1951 New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) Retail Shop Assistants award (51 Book of Awards 1889). The clause in the Court's award contained a comma between the words concerned but the printed copies did not. When the 1955 award was being prepared the corresponding clause, which did not involve any alteration, was copied from a printed copy, hence the error was continued.
