AIRCRAFT ENGINEERING APPRENTICESHIP ORDER—NEW ZEALAND EXAMINA-TIONS APPROVED BY NEW ZEALAND APPRENTICESHIP COMMITTEE

In the matter of the New Zealand Aircraft Engineering Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 18th day of July 1952, and recorded in 52 Book of Awards 945.

By a resolution dated 7 February 1956, the New Zealand Aircraft Engineering Apprenticeship Committee approved for the purposes of clause 11 (b) (ii) of the order mentioned above of internal examinations in technical schools in any two of the following subjects at a second-year evening class level: physics, electrical theory, radio theory, mathematics, electronics, technical drawing, mechanics.

The resolution applies to apprentices in the aircraft radio engineering, aircraft instrument engineering, and aircraft electrical engineering branches of the industry, and is in addition to a resolution of 18 March 1954 recorded in 54 Book of Awards 187.
