# AUCKLAND HOSPITAL BOARD CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS—VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 22nd day of July 1957 between the Auckland Hospital Board (hereinafter called "the board") or ("the employer") of the one part, and the Auckland Provincial District Local Authorities Officers' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties as set out in the following Schedule.
