

**NEW ZEALAND PRINTING AND PHOTO-ENGRAVING INDUSTRIES—  
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Printing and Photo-engraving Industries Apprenticeship Order dated the 29th day of November 1954, and recorded in 54 Book of Awards 1857.

WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Printing and Photo-engraving Industries Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Printing and Photo-engraving Industries Apprenticeship Order dated the 29th day of November 1954, and recorded in 54 Book of Awards 1857: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said committee: Now therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting subclause (c) of clause 11 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

“(c) The percentages referred to in subclauses (a) and (b) of this clause are as follows:

	Commencing Before Seventeenth Birthday	Commencing On or After Seventeenth Birthday
	Per Cent	Per Cent
For the first 1,000-hour period	..... 32	38
For the second 1,000-hour period	..... 37	43
For the third 1,000-hour period	..... 42	48
For the fourth 1,000-hour period	..... 47	53
For the fifth 1,000-hour period	..... 52	58
For the sixth 1,000-hour period	..... 57	63
For the seventh 1,000-hour period	..... 62	68
For the eighth 1,000-hour period	..... 67	73
For the ninth 1,000-hour period	..... 72	78
For the tenth 1,000-hour period	..... 77	83”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
