NEW ZEALAND PAINTING AND DECORATING INDUSTRY—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Painting and Decorating Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 25th day of March 1953, and recorded in 53 Book of Awards 449.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Painting and Decorating Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Painting and Decorating Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 25th day of March 1953, and recorded in 53 Book of Awards 449: and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said committee and has afforded the employers and workers in the industry an opportunity of being heard: Now therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 11 (wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

"(a) The minimum weekly rates of wages payable to apprentices shall be the undermentioned percentages of an amount equal to forty times the minimum hourly wage rate for journeymen painters and decorators, as prescribed by the award or agreement relating to the employment of such journeymen in the establishment in which the apprentice is employed and in force for the time being and from time to time:
