

WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL **MUNICIPAL OFFICERS**—VARIATION OF AGREEMENT UNDER THE LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT 1913

THIS agreement made the 13th December 1957 between the corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Wellington and the Wellington Municipal Officers' Association (Incorporated) witnesseth as follows:

1. That clause 4 of the agreement made between the parties on 11 October 1956 (1956 Book of Awards 1589) hereinafter called "the principal agreement" is varied by revoking subclauses (a) and (b) thereof and substituting the following:

(a) The rates of salaries and conditions set forth in the Officers' Classification effective on 1 April 1957 shall apply to the principal agreement.

(b) Whereas the rates of remuneration in the said Officers' Classification incorporate the increase prescribed by the general order of the Court of Arbitration dated 26 October 1956 and other increases granted voluntarily by the council in the years 1955, 1956 and 1957 the corporation in making any determination as to the action to be taken with respect to any future general order of the said Court during the currency of the principal agreement shall be guided by the action of the Government with respect to the salary rates of its employees as the result of such general order: Provided always that nothing in this subclause shall be construed as a waiver by the corporation or the association of any right or power which may be conferred on it to apply to the said Court for any relief from or modification of any such future general order.

2. The agreement made on 22 November 1956 (1956 Book of Awards 1873) varying the terms of the principal agreement is revoked.
