

DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL **SHIFT ENGINEERS**—VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

THIS industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 16th day of April 1957, between the Otago and Southland Engineers, Motor Mechanics, Aircraft, and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union"), of the one part, and the corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the city of Dunedin (hereinafter referred to as "the employer"), of the other part, witnesseth that it is hereby mutually agreed between the employer and the union as follows.

SCHEDULE

1. That the wage rates set out in the industrial agreement between the employer and the union dated 2 March 1956, clause 9 (wages) subclauses (a), (c) and (d), and amended by a variation of the said agreement dated 23 August 1956, be and are hereby further amended by deleting the said subclauses and substituting in lieu thereof the following subclauses, viz.:

9.(a) The minimum rate of wages at Waipori shall be:

First shift engineer	£895 per annum plus £13 per annum remote allowance.
Second shift engineer	£850 per annum plus £13 per annum remote allowance.
Third shift engineer	
Fourth shift engineer	
Fifth shift engineer	
Sixth shift engineer	£765 per annum plus £13 per annum remote allowance.
Seventh shift engineer	
Eighth shift engineer	
Relieving engineer	
Automatic station engineers (Nos. 3, 4 stations)	£850 per annum plus £13 per annum remote allowance.

(c) The minimum rate of wages at Halfway Bush and the Converter Station shall be:

	Per Annum £
First year	810
Second year	830
Third year	850

(d) The first shift engineer at Halfway Bush and the first shift engineer at the Converter Station shall be paid £895 per annum.

2. That the amendment provided for in clause 1 hereof shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of November 1956.
