

DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES **LABOURERS**—VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 29th day of January 1957, between the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Dunedin, (hereinafter called the "employer") of the one part, and the Otago Labourers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called the "union") of the other part, witnesseth that it is hereby mutually agreed between the employer and the union as follows:

SCHEDULE

1. That the minimum rate of wages payable for ordinary hours of work prescribed by clause 2 (a) of the industrial agreement between the employer and the union dated 23 November 1955 shall be increased from £11 to £11 10s. per week.

2. That the new minimum rate shall not be subject to the general order of the Court of Arbitration dated 26 October 1956, which increased rates of remuneration prescribed by awards and industrial agreements by an amount equal to 18 per cent thereof.

3. That this amendment shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of November 1956.
