

NEW ZEALAND **ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY**—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP
ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Electrical Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 7th day of June 1955, and recorded in 55 Book of Awards 793.

WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Electrical Trades Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Electrical Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 7th day of June 1955, and recorded in 55 Book of Awards 793: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting subclause (b) of clause 4 (Prior Consent of Committee) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

“(b) Any person or company, before taking an apprentice to learn a branch of the industry, shall first satisfy the local committee that he is or will be a suitable employer, has been in business in the branch of the industry for at least 12 months, is in a position to continue in business, and has the facilities for properly teaching the apprentice that branch of the industry.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.

NEW ZEALAND ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY APPRENTICESHIP ORDER—SUBJECTS
APPROVED BY NEW ZEALAND APPRENTICESHIP COMMITTEE

In the matter of the New Zealand Electrical Industry Apprenticeship Order dated 7 June 1955, and recorded in 55 Book of Awards 793.

By a resolution dated 1 September 1958 the New Zealand Electrical Trades Apprenticeship Committee approved for the purpose of clause 8 (b) of the order mentioned above the following subjects of the School Certificate Examination: English, and any one of the following—mathematics, technical drawing, applied mechanics, engineering shop work theory and practice, general science, physics, electricity, chemistry.

NOTE—This resolution takes account of changes in School Certificate subjects, but an earlier resolution recorded in 50 Book of Awards 846 remains in force also.
