

NEW ZEALAND PLUMBING AND GASFITTING INDUSTRY—AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 7th day of May 1957, and recorded in 57 Book of Awards 582.

WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 7th day of May 1957: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said committee: Now therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting paragraph (i) of subclause (c) of clause 11 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:

“(i) Every apprentice who, whether he has been ordered to attend classes or not, shall have obtained from the New Zealand Trades Certification Board a notification that he has passed the First Qualifying Examination of that Board shall from the 1st January following the sitting of that Examination be paid for the remainder of his apprenticeship at a rate not less than 2s. 6d. a week in excess of the minimum rate provided in subclause (a) of this clause; and if he produces a notification of a pass in the Second Qualifying Examination of that Board be paid from the 1st January following the sitting of that Examination and during the remainder of his apprenticeship at a rate of not less than 7s. 6d. a week in excess of the minimum rate provided in subclause (a) of this clause.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
