

DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES' **LABOURERS**—VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 19th day of February 1959, between the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Dunedin, the Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board, and the Ocean Beach Domain Board, Dunedin, C. 1. (hereinafter called "the employer") of the one part, and the Otago Labourers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the other part, witnesseth that it is hereby mutually agreed between the employer and the union as follows:

SCHEDULE

(1) That workers engaged on water wastage detection, be employed under the terms and conditions of the Dunedin Local Bodies Labourers' Agreement, dated 6 November 1957, and published in the 1957 Book of Awards at page 1473, which agreement shall be varied whilst workers are so employed by the following special conditions:

- (a) That the council may employ these workers on water waste detection only, for a period of not more than 40 hours per week, such duties to be performed between the hours of 11.30 p.m. and 7.30 a.m. of the following day at ordinary rates of pay.

- (b) That the weekly rate of wages shall not be less than £11 15s. per week, or £12 per week if the appointees have at least 12 months continuous service with the council or Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board, plus 1s. per hour extra whilst employed during the night hours.
- (c) That the council shall have the right to cease night work from time to time, and to employ the workers concerned on repair work, in normal working hours, consequent on leakages detected by them, the workers to be then employed under the terms and conditions of the Labourers' Agreement.
- (d) That the following clauses of the Labourers' Agreement shall not apply to these workers, whilst performing night work:

Clause 1 – Hours of Work.

Clause 2 – Wages.

Clause 3 – Overtime.

- (2) That this variation shall operate only during the currency of the existing agreement referred to in clause (1) hereof.
