
**NEW ZEALAND CARPENTRY AND JOINERY INDUSTRY—AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Carpentry and Joinery Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 15th day of May 1961, and recorded in the 61 Book of Awards 436.

WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Carpentry and Joinery Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Carpentry and Joinery Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 15th day of May 1961, and recorded in the 61 Book of Awards 436: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended in the manner following:

(1) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 11 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

“(b) (i) Every apprentice who produces to his employer a notification from the New Zealand Trades Certification Board that he has passed the First Qualifying Examination of that Board shall from the date of that notification be paid for the remainder of his apprenticeship not less than 10s. a week in excess of the minimum wages prescribed in subclause (a) of this clause; and if he produces to his employer a notification that he has passed the Second Qualifying Examination of that Board he shall from the date of the notification be paid for the remainder of his apprenticeship not less than 15s. a week in excess of the minimum wage prescribed in subclause (a) of this clause.

(ii) An apprentice who has been exempted from the First Qualifying Examination shall from the date of production to his employer of the notification of exemption be paid not less than 10s. a week in excess of the minimum wages prescribed in subclause (a) of this clause.”

(2) By adding to the Second Schedule the following:

“Joinery Machining Apprentices—

Rule; plane and oilstone; square; level; hammer; screwdrivers (large and small); gauge; pliers; crescent spanners (two sizes); callipers; nail punches and hacksaw, all in a suitable tool box.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
