

NEW ZEALAND HARBOUR BOARDS' HARBOURMASTERS AND PILOTS—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Harbour Boards' Harbourmasters and Pilots Award, dated the 2nd day of September 1965, and recorded in 65 Book of Awards . . .

UPON reading the joint application made on behalf of the original parties to the New Zealand Harbour Boards' Harbourmasters and Pilots Award, dated the 2nd day of September 1965, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and with the consent of the said original parties, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding to clause 3 (Salary Payments) under the heading "Lyttelton" and after the classification "Junior Pilot" the following new classification and rate of salary:
