

NEW ZEALAND LOCAL BODIES (RURAL SECTION) **LABOURERS**—AMENDMENT  
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Local Bodies (Rural Section) Labourers Award, dated the 1st day of July 1966, and recorded in 66 Book of Awards . . .

THURSDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF JULY 1966

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 162 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Local Bodies (Rural Section) Labourers Award, dated the 1st day of July 1966, the Court doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting from subclause (a) of clause 5 (Wages) the words and figures “Casual workers, 7s. 10d. (78.333 cents) per hour.” and substituting therefor the words and figures “Casual workers, 7s. 10½d. (78.750 cents) per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 18th day of June 1966.
