**WELLINGTON, MARLBOROUGH, NELSON, AND WESTLAND ROOFERS, TILERS,
AND FLOOR-LAYERS—ORDER EXTENDING SCOPE TO INCLUDE TARANAKI I.D.
AND ADDING PARTIES**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District—
In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in
the matter of the Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, and Westland Roofers,
Tilers, and Floor-Layers Award, dated the 25th day of July 1966, and recorded
in 66 Book of Awards.

UPON reading the application to extend the Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, and
Westland Roofers, Tilers, and Floor-layers Award, dated the 25th day of July
1966, so as to add parties in another industrial district, which application was
made by the Wellington, Nelson, Westland, and Marlborough Local Bodies',
Other Labourers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers party to the
said award and was filed on the 2nd day of August 1966: And upon being
satisfied that due notice of the said application has been given to the union and
companies hereinafter named, and that no written notice of opposition to the
said application has been received by the Clerk of Awards: And upon being
satisfied that conditions of employment or of trade are such as to make it
equitable to do so, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers con-
ferred upon it by sections 158 and 160 of the Industrial Conciliation and
Arbitration Act 1954, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the undermentioned union and companies be and they are hereby
added as parties to the said award:

Northern and Taranaki Labourers', General Workers and Related Trades
Industrial Union of Workers, "Union House", corner West and Galatos
Streets, Newton, Auckland.

Dominion Contractors Ltd., Glover Road, Hawera.

Firth Tile Co., Stratford.

Floor Styles Ltd., 50 Egmont Street, New Plymouth.

Winstone Ltd., Elliott Street, New Plymouth.

2. That the locality to which the said award relates be and it is hereby
extended to include the Taranaki Industrial District.

3. That this order shall take effect on the day of the date hereof.
