

**DUNEDIN CITY CORPORATION ENGINE DRIVERS—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

THIS industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this ninth day of May 1967, between the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Dunedin (hereinafter referred to as "the employer") of the one part and the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen, Greasers and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter referred to as "the union") of the other part whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties hereto as follows, that is to say:

SCHEDULE

*Industry to which Agreement Applies*

1. This agreement shall apply to engine drivers employed by the Dunedin City Corporation Gas Department.

*Wages*

2. Although the work at the City Gasworks requires only an engine driver with a second-class certificate, the minimum rate of wages to be paid to engine drivers employed under this agreement shall be the rate of wages set out in the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen and Greasers (General Section) Award for drivers with a first-class certificate, provided, firstly, that engine drivers who have completed one year's service shall receive an additional 5s. per week, and, secondly, that the amount payable to workers covered by this agreement shall not be less than 1d. per hour more than the amount payable to water gas operators under the Dunedin City Council Gasworks Employees Industrial Agreement for the time being in force.

*Duties*

3. In addition to the normal duties of an engine driver, workers employed under this agreement shall undertake to stoke the solid fuel boiler at the Gasworks as and when required.

*Holidays, Overtime, and Weekend Work*

4. In lieu of the provision for holidays, overtime and weekend work within the 40-hour week under the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen and Greasers (General Section) Award, workers employed under this agreement shall receive the same holidays and the same conditions in respect of overtime as shiftworkers under the Dunedin City Council Gaswork Employees Industrial Agreement.

*Other Terms and Conditions*

5. In all other respects the conditions of employment shall be as prescribed in the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen and Greasers (General Section) Award.

*Term of Agreement*

6. This agreement shall come into force on the day of the date hereof and shall continue in force until the 31st day of October 1968.
