

N.Z. FOREST PRODUCTS LIMITED, FIBRE PRODUCTS (NEW ZEALAND) LIMITED,
AND WHAKATANE BOARD MILLS LIMITED **PULP AND PAPER WORKERS—**
VARIATION OF AGREEMENT UNDER THE L.D.I. ACT 1913

In the matter of an industrial agreement dated the 28th day of November 1966 and made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act 1913 between the New Zealand Federation of Woodpulp, Paper and Paper Products Workers of the one part and New Zealand Forest Products Limited, Fibre Products (New Zealand) Limited and Whakatane Board Mills Limited of the other part.

It is hereby agreed between the parties that the industrial agreement dated 28 November 1966 shall be varied in the manner following:

1. "By deleting from sub-clause (d) of clause 11 thereof the words "N.Z. Forest Products Limited at Kinleith and" and adding the following new sub-clause:

(f) The following rates of pay shall apply to female workers employed by N.Z. Forest Products Limited at Kinleith:
