NEW ZEALAND ENGINEERING INDUSTRY -AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

1/8/69.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand-In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Engineering Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 4th day of October 1967, and recorded in 67 Book of Awards 2369.

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Engineering Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 4th day of October 1967, this Court doth order that the said apprenticeship order shall be and it is hereby amended as follows:

By adding at the end of the Schedule of operations and skills for Scale Mechanics (as inserted by amendment dated 11 February 1969) the following paragraph —

"Training on items 1 to 8 above is to total 40 per cent of the term of apprenticeship and training on items 9 to 12 60 per cent of the term of apprenticeship."
