

NEW ZEALAND LICENSED HOTELS' EMPLOYEES—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Licensed Hotels' Employees Award, dated the 15th day of December 1969, and recorded in 69 Book of Awards

Upon reading the joint application made by the New Zealand Federated Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant, and Related Trades' Employees Industrial Association of Workers, and the Hotel Association of New Zealand Industrial Association of Employers parties to the New Zealand Licensed Hotels' Employees Award, dated the 15th day of December 1969: And Upon being satisfied that the original parties to the award are desirous that the award should be reviewed by it, The Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and with the consent of the said parties, Doth Hereby Order as follows:

That the said award be and it is hereby amended by deleting the figures and words "19th day of January 1971" where they appear in the enacting sheet and in clause 27 (Term of Award) and substituting therefor in each case the figures and words "18th day of August 1970".
