## DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL GASWORKS EMPLOYEES - VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This Industrial Agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1954, this 3rd day of September, 1970, between the Dunedin City Council (hereinafter called "the employer") of the one part and the Otago and Southland Gasworks and Related Trades Employees' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the other part witnesseth that it is hereby mutually agreed between the union and the employer as follows:—

## SCHEDULE

 The Industrial Agreement dated 22nd April 1969 between the employer and the union be and is hereby amended as follows:-

## Wages

(a) The minimum rate of wages to be paid in accordance with Clause 2 (a) shall be:-

The Loco Driver and other employees required to hold an Engine Drivers Ticket shall be paid at the appropriate rate provided in the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen and Greasers (General Section) Award in force for the time being.

(c) Employees appointed to the position of Shift Foreman shall receive an allowance of \$5.50 per week, not subject to any increment for overtime or any other cause, such sum to be added to the weekly pay after all calculations of pay have been completed.

## Term of Agreement

This Industrial Agreement shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1968 and shall continue in force to the 31st day of October 1970 except insofar as it relates to Clause 3 (as amended) which shall continue into force until the 31st day of October 1971.

 The amendments provided for in Clause 1 hereof shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th day of May 1970.
