NEW ZEALAND HARBOUR BOARDS' HARBOURMASTERS AND PILOTS – – AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Harbour Boards' Harbourmasters and Pilots Award, dated the 4th day of February 1969, and recorded in 69 Book of Awards p.52

Upon reading the joint application made by the New Zealand Merchant Service Guild Industrial Union of Workers and the New Zealand Harbour Boards Industrial Union of Employers on behalf of the original parties to the New Zealand Harbour Boards Harbourmasters and Pilots Award, dated the 4th day of February 1969: and upon being satisfied that the said parties are desirous that the award should be reviewed by it, The Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, and with the consent of the said parties, doth hereby order as follows:

That the said award shall be and it is hereby amended by deleting the figures and words "30th day of November 1970" where they appear in the enacting sheet and in clause 14 (Term of Award) and substituting therefor in each case the figures and words "15th day of September 1970".
