

AUCKLAND (25-mile radius) PASSENGER TRANSPORT DRIVERS  
— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the Auckland (25-mile radius) Passenger Transport Drivers Award, dated the 28th day of November 1968, and recorded in 68 Book of Awards p. 640

Upon reading the joint application made by the original parties to the Auckland (25-mile radius) Passenger Transport Drivers Award, dated the 28th day of November 1968: And upon being satisfied that the said parties are desirous that the award should be reviewed by it, The Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and with the consent of the said parties, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated 19 February 1970) shall be further amended by deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:

“WAGES

3. Except in the case of casual drivers, the minimum rate of wages for omnibus drivers covered by this award shall be \$45.20 per week.”
2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th day of June 1970.
