

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT GOLF CLUBS', TENNIS CLUBS',
AND OTHER SPORTS—BODIES GREENKEEPERS — AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Golf Clubs', Tennis Clubs', and Other Sports Bodies' Greenkeepers Award, dated the 2nd day of September 1969, and recorded in 69 Book of Awards p. 1821

Upon reading the joint application made by the original parties to the Northern Industrial District Golf Clubs', Tennis Clubs', and other Sports-Bodies' Greenkeepers Award, dated the 2nd day of September 1969: And upon being satisfied that the said parties are desirous that the award should be reviewed by it, The Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and with the consent of the said parties, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be:

	Per Week
	\$
Head greenkeeper	44.92
Sole greenkeeper	42.92
Other greenkeepers	40.52

Greenkeepers after two years' service with the same club shall be paid \$1.08 per week extra.”

(2) By deleting the figures and words “20th day of January 1971” where they appear in the enacting sheet and in clause 19 (Term of Award) and substituting therefor in each case the figures and words “31st day of May 1971”.

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof, except that in so far as it relates to the rates of wages to be paid it shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July 1970.
