NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT MARLBOROUGH AND OTAGO AND SOUTH-LAND) BREWERY AND BOTTLING HOUSE WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Westland, and Canterbury Industrial Districts—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Marlborough and Otago and Southland) Brewery and Bottling House Workers Award, dated the 3rd day of December 1969, and recorded in 69 Book of Awards. . . .
