In the matter of an industrial agreement dated 30th day of December 1969, and made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, between New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen, Greasers and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers of the one part and New Zealand Paper Mills Limited of the other part.

It is hereby agreed between the parties that the industrial agreement dated 30th day of December 1969 shall be varied in the manner following.

1. Clause 11 (a) and (b) By deleting sub-clauses (a) and (b) of clause 11 and substituting the following new sub-clauses (a) and (b) of clause 11.

" 17 . The rates of remuneration determined by this agreement shall be subject to the general order of the Court of Arbitration dated 3rd November 1970."
3. Term of Agreement-By deleting the words "13th day of June 1971" and substituting therefor the words "11th day of July, 1971."
