

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT WESTLAND) MEAT PROCESSORS, PACKERS,  
AND PRESERVERS, FREEZING WORKS – AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts-In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; And in the matter of the New Zealand (except Westland) Meat Processors, Packers and Preservers, Freezing Works Award, dated the 20th day of December 1968, and recorded in 68 Book of Awards . . . . .

Upon reading the joint application made by the original parties to the New Zealand (except Westland) Meat Processors, Packers and Preservers, Freezing Works Award, dated the 20th day of December 1968: And upon being satisfied that the said parties are desirous that the award should be reviewed by it, The Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 162 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and with the consent of the said parties, Doth hereby order as follows:

That the said award shall be and it is hereby amended by deleting the figures and words "30th day of June 1970" where they appear in the enacting sheet and in clause 60 (Term of Award) and substituting therefor in each case the figures and words "25th day of March 1970".
