

NEW ZEALAND PLUMBING AND GASFITTING INDUSTRY—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 22nd day of August 1967, and recorded in 67 Book of Awards 1683.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Plumbing and Gasfitting Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 22nd day of August 1967: and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting subclause (g) of clause 10 (Proportion) and substituting therefore the following subclause:

“(g) No employer shall be permitted to employ apprentices to the branches of plumbing, gasfitting, or plumbing and gasfitting who is not a registered plumber or a registered gasfitter or who does not employ a registered plumber or a registered gasfitter as the case may require.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof. Dated this 10th day of June 1971.
