

NEW ZEALAND WAREHOUSEMEN—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Warehousemen Award, dated the 9th day of February 1970, and recorded in 70 Book of Awards p. 190.

Upon reading the application duly made in accordance with section 6 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act 1970 for amendment of the New Zealand Warehousemen Award, dated the 9th day of February 1970: the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the power conferred on it by the said section, doth hereby order as follows:

That the said award shall be and it is hereby amended by deleting the date “15th day of June 1971” where it appears in the enacting sheet and in clause 27 (Term of Award) and substituting therefor the date “30th day of September 1970”.
