

## BULLER HOSPITAL EMPLOYEES – INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 23rd day of November 1971, between the West Coast Hospital Board (hereinafter called "the board") of the one part, and the Wellington, Nelson, Westland and Marlborough Local Bodies, other Labourers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called the "union") of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties as set out in the following Schedule.

### SCHEDULE

Save for the provisions set out herein, the terms and conditions of the Wellington Marlborough, Nelson and Westland Hospital Boards Gardeners, Labourers and other Workers' Industrial Agreement for the time in force or any award made by the Court of Arbitration, or industrial agreement entered into, in substitution therefor shall stand part of this industrial agreement.

### SERVICE BONUS

1. Workers who have been in the employ of the Board for three years, or who may subsequently attain a service of three years shall be paid an additional payment as follows:
