

NEW ZEALAND AMBULANCE DRIVING OFFICERS—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This Industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954 and its amendments, this 14th day of June 1971 between the New Zealand Road Transport and Motor and Horse Drivers and their Assistants Industrial Association of Workers of the one part and the New Zealand Hospital Boards Industrial Union of Employers of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. That the terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions contained and set out in the Schedule hereto shall be binding upon the parties hereto, and they shall be deemed to be and are hereby declared to form part of this agreement.

2. That the said parties hereto shall respectively do, observe and perform every matter and thing by this agreement and by the said terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions respectively required to be done, observed and performed and shall not do anything in contravention of this agreement or of the said terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions, but shall in all respects abide by and perform the same.

SCHEDULE

INDUSTRY TO WHICH AGREEMENT APPLIES

1. This agreement shall apply to ambulance driving officers.

WAGES

2. The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:

(i) For officers who have passed the Intermediate Grade Examination conducted for certification of New Zealand ambulance driving officers as approved by the Ambulance Transport Advisory Board	53.31
(ii) For officers who have passed the basic Grade Examination conducted for certification of New Zealand ambulance driving officers as approved by the Ambulance Transport Advisory Board	52.44
(iii) For officers who are holders of valid St. John Ambulance Association, Red Cross Society, or St. Andrew's Association first aid and home nursing certificates or who are the holders of a St. John's Medallion or who have held a Red Cross Society Medallion for not less than one year. ..	51.97
(iv) For other officers	51.31

GENERAL WAGE ORDER

3. The rates of remuneration provided herein are not to be increased by the general order of the Court of Arbitration made under the General Wage Orders Act 1969 and dated the 3rd day of November 1970.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

4. So far as all other conditions of employment are concerned, the provisions of the current New Zealand Ambulance Driving Officers Award, dated the 28th day of July 1970 with the exception of subclause (a) of clause 4, shall apply.

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

5. This agreement shall operate throughout the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

6. This agreement shall come into force on the 17th day of May, 1971, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of July, 1971, and thereafter until the current New Zealand Ambulance Driving Officers Award dated the 28th day of July, 1970, is superseded by a new award.
