This Industrial Agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and its amendments, this 16th day of June 1971, between the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Driver Engineers, Marine Engine Drivers, Greasers, Firemen and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers (Auckland Branch), (hereinafter referred to as "the Union") of the one part and members of the Auckland Provincial Employers' Association as listed (hereinafter referred to as "the Employer") of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. That the terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions contained and set out in the Schedule hereto shall be binding upon the parties hereto, and they shall be

deemed to be and are hereby declared to form part of this agreement.

2. That the said parties hereto shall respectively do, observe and perform every matter and thing by this agreement and by the said terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions respectively required to be done, observed and performed and shall not do anything in contravention of this agreement or of the said terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions, but shall in all respects abide by and perform the same.
