WELLINGTON CITY CORPORATION TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES — INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1954, on this twelfth day of August 1971, between the New Zealand Tramways and Public Passenger Transport Authorities Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Wellington City Corporation Transport Department:

1. Union fees payable by members of the Wellington Branch of the New Zealand Tramways and Public Passenger Transport Authorities Employees' Industrial Union of Workers shall be deducted from the weekly wages due to such members and be remitted to the union monthly; the employer shall have the right to also deduct shortages from the weekly wages due to such employees up to a maximum amount of three dollars (\$3.00) in any one week, provided that this condition in relation to a deduction of shortages from wages shall be without prejudice to any further negotiation which may be entered into on the matter of a deduction of shortages from wages.

2. This industrial agreement shall come into effect on the 1st day of September 1971 and shall, unless invalidated by a clause providing for the deduction of union fees from wages and/or a deduction of shortages from wages being incorporated in the New Zealand Public Passenger Transport Authorities Workers Award at an earlier date, continue in force

until the 31st day of August 1974.
