

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND ENGINEDRIVERS, BOILER ATTENDANTS, FIREMEN,
AND GREASERS (HOSPITAL SECTION) – INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This Industrial Agreement made in pursuance of Section 129 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954 and its amendments this 4th day of November, 1971, between the New Zealand Enginedrivers, Firemen and Greasers and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers, the “union”, on the one part, and the Waitaki Hospital Board, Oamaru and Southland Hospital Board, Invercargill, “the employer”, of the other part, hereby witnesseth that it is mutually agreed and declared between and by the union and the employers as follows:

SCHEDULE

INDUSTRY TO WHICH AGREEMENT APPLIES

1. This agreement shall apply to enginedrives, boiler attendants, firemen and greasers and to workers substantially employed in assisting enginedrivers, boiler attendants and/or firemen in the employ of all hospital boards and other hospitals throughout the Otago and Southland Industrial District parties to this agreement.

WAGES

2. (a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:

	Per Week \$
(i) Workers holding a first-class certificate	57.20
(ii) Workers holding an endorsed second-class certificate	54.40
(iii) Workers holding a second-class certificate	53.20
(iv) Workers holding a boiler attendant's certificate	49.60
(v) Workers who hold no certificate	47.60

(b) The certificates referred to in subclause (a) of this clause shall be certificates issued pursuant to the Boilers, Lifts and Cranes Act 1950 and its amendments.

(c) The above rates for the certificates shall apply only from the date the worker produces evidence that he is so qualified.

(d) A worker who holds a certificate from the New Zealand Trades Certification Board that he has passed an examination in boilerhouse practice shall be paid an additional 35 cents per week.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD TO APPLY

3. The terms and conditions of the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Boiler Attendants, Firemen and Greasers (Hospital Section) Award dated 21st July, 1970, shall, except as hereinbefore varied, apply to all workers covered by this agreement.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

4. This agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of the pay period in each establishment commencing on or after 1st May, 1971.

STABILISATION OF REMUNERATION ACT, 1971

5. This agreement is made subject to Section 13 of the Stabilisation of Remuneration Act, 1971.
