

**AUCKLAND, WAIKATO, COOK, NORTHLAND, TAURANGA,  
TAUMARANUI, THAMES, OPOTIKI, AND BAY OF PLENTY  
HOSPITAL BOARDS' LAUNDRY EMPLOYEES—VARIATION OF  
INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

This Industrial Agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this Third day of March 1971, between The Auckland, Waikato, Cook, Northland, Tauranga, Taumarunui, Thames, Opotiki and Bay of Plenty Hospital Boards and The Northern District Laundries', Dyers' and Dry-Cleaners' Employees Industrial Union of Workers.

Whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties that the Industrial Agreement made between the parties on the twenty-eighth day of August 1967 shall be and is hereby varied in the manner following:

- (i) Clause 3 (b) Increase rate to 72 cents per shift.
