

NEW ZEALAND ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY—AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Electrical Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 7th day of November 1969, and recorded in 69 Book of Awards 2331.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Electrical Trades Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Electrical Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 7th day of November 1969: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee and has heard the employers, workers, and other persons concerned: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended in the manner following—
 - (1) By deleting paragraph (b) of clause 1 (Industry to which Order applies) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:
“(b) Electrical appliance servicing,”
 - (2) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 10 (Proportion) and substituting therefor the following subclause:
“(b) In the electrical appliance servicing branch the proportion of apprentices shall not be more than one to every journeyman employed who holds an ‘E’, ‘ET’, ‘EM’ class licence or who has limited registration.”
 - (3) By deleting from the Schedule of Operations and Skills the caption “Electrical Servicing” for part 2 and substituting therefor the caption “Electrical Appliance Servicing”.
2. That this Order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
