## NEW ZEALAND MUSICIANS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the New Zealand Musicians Award, dated the 4th day of October 1971, and recorded in 71 Book of Awards 2608.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Court by section 130 (2) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954: and upon application duly made in that behalf and with the concurrence of the union of workers concerned, partial exemption from the provision of the New Zealand Musicians Award, dated the 4th day of October 1971, is hereby granted to the Symphonia of Auckland Foundation Incorporated and the Christchurch Civic Orchestra Foundation Incorporated as follows:

1. The provisions of clause 9 (Recorded, Televised, or Filmed Performances) shall not apply in respect of recording rights payments for orchestral performances recorded by the New Zealand Broadcasting Corporation in cases where the wages for such performances are paid from the funds of the Foundation concerned.

2. The provisions of subclause (b) of clause 10 (Holidays) prescribing the payment to be made for work performed on a Sunday shall not apply on special occasions (e.g. Sunday benefit concerts) where the players may, by a majority, vote to work for a rate of time and a quarter.
