

NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, NELSON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO
AND SOUTHLAND FOREMEN STEVEDORES, TIME-KEEPERS, AND
PERMANENT HANDS – ORDER EXTENDING SCOPE AND
ADDING PARTIES

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District – In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Foremen Stevedores, Time-keepers, and Permanent Hands Award, dated the 6th day of April 1973.

Upon reading the application to extend the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Foremen Stevedores, Time-keepers, and Permanent Hands Award, dated the 6th day of April 1973, so as to add parties in an industrial district in which the award has effect but outside the locality to which the award relates, which application was made by a party to the said award and was filed herein on the 28th day of June 1973: and upon being satisfied that the said application has the concurrence of the unions hereinafter named: and upon being satisfied that a majority of the employers in the locality to which the award relates are already bound by the award, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 157 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, doth hereby make orders as follows:

1. That the undermentioned unions be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award –

Napier Waterside Employers' Union Industrial Union of Employers, Hawke's Bay
County Council Building, Browning Street, Napier.

Napier Foremen Stevedores, Time-keepers and Permanent Hands Industrial Union
of Workers, 15 Taradale Road, Napier.

2. That the locality to which the said award relates be and it is hereby extended so as to include the Port of Napier.
