NEW ZEALAND SIGNWRITING INDUSTRY – AMENDMENT
OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 16/12/74

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand – In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Signwriting Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 2nd day of October 1972, and recorded in 72 Book of Awards 3339.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Painting and Decorating Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Signwriting Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 2nd day of October 1972: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by inserting after the words “New Zealand Trades Certification Board” in subclause (c) of clause 11 (Wages) the words “and who has 1,000 hours or less of his apprenticeship to serve”.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
