NEW ZEALAND FOOTWEAR MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY – AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 27/6/74

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand – In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Footwear Manufacturing Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 16th day of June 1972, and recorded in 72 Book of Awards 2650.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Footwear Manufacturing Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Footwear Manufacturing Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 16th day of June 1972: and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: now, therefore, the Court in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the Schedule of Training Skills to the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting paragraph 3 of Part 1 of the skills for Slipper Manufacture and substituting therefor the following paragraph

“3. Making Department –

- (a) Care, use, and general maintenance of hand tools.
- (b) Correct setting up, care, general maintenance and operation of all machines used in the department.
- (c) Skills in all operations used in the department.
- (d) Thorough knowledge of all materials used in the manufactures of slippers.
- (e) General knowledge of trade measurements, trade technology, safety, housekeeping, production records, and factory administration.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
